VOTERS MUST SHOW PHOTO ID FROM 4 MAY 2023

The UK Government has introduced a requirement for voter to show photo ID when voting at a polling station at the elections listed above. This will apply at the local, town and parish election on **Thursday 4 May 2023**.

Any of the following can be used: Passport, Driving licence (including provisional license), Blue badge, Certain concessionary travel cards, Identity card with PASS mark (Proof of Age Standards Scheme), Biometric Immigration document, Defence identity card, Certain national identity cards. If an elector doesn't already have an accepted form of photo ID they can apply for a free **Voter Authority Certificate** at voter-authority-certificate.service.gov.uk.
